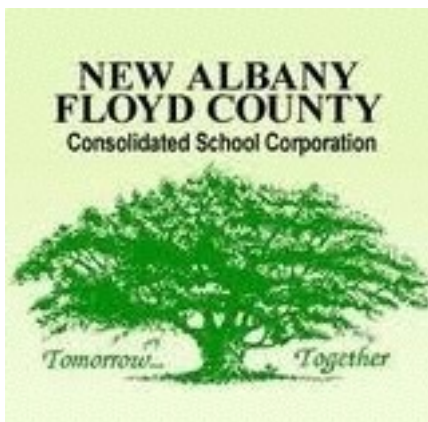


## MISSION:
