Supply List for Kindergarten

Please bring materials to Open House on July 26

- ❖ full sized backpack (come winter, your child will be putting his/her winter coat inside it, and the full size usually accommodates this nicely) clearly labeled with child's name

- ❖ 2 plastic folders with prongs and 2 pockets

- ❖ 2 regular size boxes of Kleenex

- ❖ 1 large box of sandwich sized Ziploc baggies

- ❖ Boys: 1 large box of gallon sized Ziploc baggies

- ❖ Girls: 1 large box of snack sized Ziploc baggies

- ❖ 1 3-hole zippered pencil pouch (that fits in the folder prongs) clear plastic or with a see-through window.

Please do not write your child's name on supplies. We supply the kindergartners with typical supplies i.e. pencils, crayons, glue, paint, scissors, and paper, so please do not send these items to school.

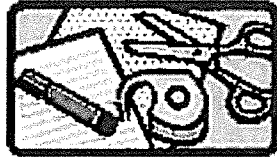
Please DO NOT put your child's names on any of the supplies.

2ND GRADE SUPPLY LIST

5. Two boxes of 24 #2 yellow pencils (Ticonderoga or USA Gold Pencils preferred)
6. Two packages of large pink erasers

9. Three -Composition Notebooks; wide ruled; NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS PLEASE (Please write your child's name on the cover of each notebook).
10. One plain plastic folder of each: red, yellow, green, and blue (*If you purchase paper folders, please purchase two of each color.) Please write your child's name on the front of the folder.
11. One package of low-odor Expo dry erase markers
12. One set of headphones or ear buds
13. One small, plastic school box that snaps shut (5x8 inches)

- one large box of gallon size Ziploc bags

If your child's last name is N-Z:

- one large box of sandwich size Ziploc bags

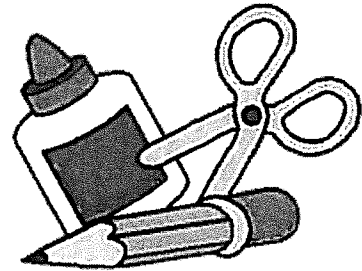
