Featuring a series designed to spark the interest of 4-H members in grades 6-12 to the elements of **4-H Geology!** Kids will learn about the geology of Indiana and how karst systems evolved based on above and below ground stream processes. Kids will be introduced to caves, the formations they make, the ecosystems and abundant life that dwell beneath the surface. In addition to the science behind caves, kids will learn proper caving techniques for safety as well as leadership and communication skills as they use teamwork to venture through the passages.

There is a **\$15** fee (in addition to the one-time 2018-19 4-H Program fee) to participate in this class to cover the cost of supplies.
On the 13th, please wear clothing that you don't mind getting dirty! You WILL be caving!
