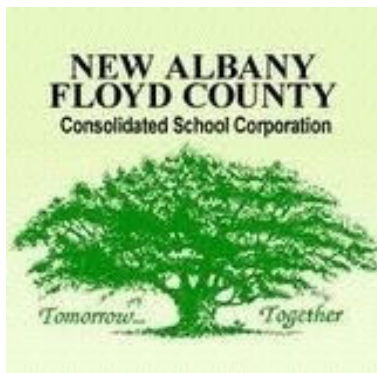


MISSION:
