Dear Art Teachers, Teachers and Principals,

Louisville Visual Art welcomes your **recommendations to the Children's Fine Art Classes for the Spring 2023 semester. Children's Fine Art Classes are a scholarship program. High quality extracurricular art classes are taught by professional artist instructors and made available to all qualified students regardless of their economic status. Educators, community leaders, and artists can recommend up to four (4) students for CFAC each semester, if you are a host site you may recommend up to eight (8) students. Previously recommended students do not need additional recommendations to continue in the program. Placement in classes is on a first-come, first-served basis, so earlier recommendation makes it more likely a student will receive their first-choice class.

Each CFAC participant must be at least 9 years old or in 4th grade and be recommended by an art teacher, school principal, community leader (pastor, service club member, elected official, etc.), or local artist who can speak to the student's motivation and demonstrated ability in visual art. Recommendations are for grades 4 through 8. Each student is provided a scholarship to attend so that economic status will play no part in a child's participation or placement. LVA does ask for an administration fee, but if a student is on Free and Reduced Lunch, they may waive that fee.

Once LVA receives a recommendation, a letter goes to parents introducing them to CFAC and LVA, and telling them to expect an email in mid-July (for Fall) or

mid-November (for Spring) about schedules and registration procedures.
Registration starts at the beginning of August and December.

Registration for the Spring 2023 semester starts December 1, classes start the week of January 17th.

Our high school program, The Academy of LVA is a tuition-based program, so no recommendation is needed. Teachers and students may learn about the [Academy program at this link](#).

** A recommendation identifies the nominated student as having the potential to perform at a high level in the visual arts, and the maturity to engage with art class activities in a responsible manner that does not disrupt classmates' participation.
