

New Albany Floyd County Schools 2022-2023 Dyslexia Reporting

In accordance with SEA 217(2018), New Albany Floyd County Schools screened all kindergarten, first grade, and second grade students to gather information pertaining to six subset areas: phonological and phonemic awareness, alphabet knowledge, sound symbol relationship, decoding skills, rapid naming skills, and encoding skills. For students scoring in the “at risk” or “at some risk” range, the multisensory intervention based on Orton Gillingham was provided.

Number of students administered initial (universal) screener during the 2022-2023 school year: 2,627

Number of students found to be “at risk” or “at some risk” for the characteristics of dyslexia during the 2022-2023 school year: 1,246

Number of students who received the dyslexia intervention during the 2022-2023 school year: 1,246

Number of students identified with dyslexia during the 2022-2023 school year: 46
